- The abstract of the research paper must be submitted online as an email attachment.
- The abstract of the research paper should be typed only in MS Word format Times New Roman, Font size 12, and line spacing 1.5 with 1" margin on all sides of A4 size paper.
- The title (Font size 14) should be bold followed by the author's name(s) and affiliation (both in font size 12).
- E-mail ID (font size 10) in italics of the presenting author and should be underlined.
- The text should follow the title as a single space with font size 12, Times New Roman. Word limit 300
